



## **Announcement of the Tak Provincial Industry Office**

**Subject: Policy on Refraining from Accepting Any Gifts or Gratuities in Connection with Official Duties (No Gift Policy) for the Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)**

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The Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Industry, reaffirms its steadfast commitment to the highest standards of integrity, ethics, and transparency. In alignment with the Royal Thai Government's anti-corruption agenda and the National Reform Plan on the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct, the Office is dedicated to cultivating a workplace culture rooted in moral conduct, impartiality, and public service, where official duties are performed free from any influence of personal interest or undue benefit. This commitment also serves to uphold and enhance Thailand's international standing.

Accordingly, to give effect to these principles, including fairness, a volunteer spirit, and the prioritization of public interest over personal gain, the Office hereby announces a strict "No Gift Policy". All executives, government officials, and personnel under the Tak Provincial Industry Office, together with officials under the Office of the Minister, Ministry of Industry, are prohibited from accepting any gifts, gratuities, or benefits of any kind in connection with the performance of their official duties. If such acceptance may give rise to corruption or misconduct, both now and in the future. Exceptions are permitted only for gifts, gratuities, or other benefits expressly allowed under applicable laws, regulations, or rules issued pursuant to legal authority, or for those accepted in accordance with customary ethical practice, provided they comply with the guidelines and thresholds set by the National Anti-Corruption Commission of Thailand. Personnel must not solicit any gifts, gratuities, or benefits not explicitly permitted by law and are responsible for ensuring that this policy is clearly and fully communicated to all external parties.

All concerned parties are hereby notified and required to comply with this policy strictly and in good faith.
